Imagine Fantastic Film Festival announces that *Riddle of Fire* by director Weston Razooli will close the festival. *Riddle of Fire* had its world premiere at the last Cannes Film Festival. A nostalgic odyssey with a small budget and a big heart, *Riddle of Fire* is the most charming cinematic puzzle of the year which takes you on a ride through the forest with cross bikes, spells and blueberries. Selection Imagine Industry

Imagine is the number one platform for Fantastic film in the Netherlands, offering a stage and a meeting place for genre filmmakers. With the Imagine Industry program, Imagine has built a solid foundation for the development and improvement of Dutch genre productions by encouraging and supporting emerging



talent and established creators. *Imagine Project Platform* is a custom program for creators working on their first or second genre project (feature film or long series). Selected creators will receive feedback and/or advice from international genre experts that are part of the Imagine network. The projects are also pitched to an international jury that determines which project will participate in the Frontières co-production market in Montreal.
